The Quest for 100 (DXCC, that is!)

As I reported in the last Newsletter, I decided to try to get 100 countries confirmed from the 5B4/AI5P operation.

The good news was that I found two more countries worked (now totalling 119) in the log. Fifty-one of these were "one contact" countries. At the end of October, I had 64 confirmed with 27 (Not 26 as I reported - 0J0 being added) of these coming from the "one contact" country list.

November brought these new ones from QSL Managers: CN2OA, EK3KA, and VQ9HK.

Also 600X from Somaliland which, unfortunately, does not count for DXCC.

Direct mail brought CX8FB, DS1CCU, LX1CW, VU20XX, ZS6RAE, 9Y4LDK and 9K2KS.

The 9Y4, CX, EK, and VQ9 were "one contact" countries. Total: 74

December brought good and bad news. The good news was that the W5 Buro sent me a number of cards. The bad news was that I found out that I had two needed countries confirmed via e-qsl: Z2 and A4. I didn't bother to look them up as they don't count as far as I'm concerned (and the ARRL).

From the Buro came: OK1MSL,

ON6CW. S57KV and YU7DR. From the QSL Managers: D2BF, YA5T. ZD9IR and 4L1DX. Dimai l provi ded CE2SQE rect EA6BH. Three of this and month's cards were "one contact" countries: **ZD9**. YA. and D2. Total: 84

January 2003 brought the following new ones direct: A45XG, A61AV, CT3KN, DU1BP and 7X2DG.

The A45XG card was a "real" one vice the e-qsl.XV9DT came via the QSL Manager. All six new ones in January were "one contact" countries.

Total: 90 with 40 coming from "one contact" countries.

So I end January with optimism with getting ten more to reach the magic 100 mark. Still outstanding are a numburo cards which of should fill in a few of the missing European countries. maybe some of missing direct cards will somehow survive the world's more "interesting" postal systems.


Keep your fingers crossed!
