ADXA MEETING MINUTES

he 2004 3rd quarter meeting of the ADXA was at Pavilion 11 at

Burns Park in North Little Rock on September 18, 2004

The meeting was called to order at 1:22 PM by President Dave Jacques. Since Rick Roderick had some time constraints, we allowed Rick time at the beginning of the meeting to provide updates on things we need to be aware of. Rick addressed the following:

1) BPL is NOT going away. The FCC is pushing this issue in a big way.

- 2) About 85% of Rick's time is spend on Washington issues.
- 3) The Section Managers and the Government liaisons have info on a "call to arms". We need to write letters, faxes, emails without flaming. Be advised that Mike Ross is a ham.
- 4) Nine to 10 years ago \$200K was spent on advocacy. Now the ARRL spends \$900K.
- 5) It could be that if we can delay a decision a new technology will replace BPL with out the interference.
- 6) There is a petition to allocate subbands by bandwidth.
- 7) There are 50 to 60 things before the FCC so they are bottlenecked.
- 8) Rick is hearing a lot of good comments about LOTW. They are expecting a partnership with CQ's WAS, WAZ, and IOTA.
- New country-rules are tightening and seem to be making a difference. Integrity of the process has been restored.
- 1Ø) W9DXCC should be coming out with a big announcement soon.


