Trip to the South Pacific - 2009

My trip turned out to be one of my best as far as being interesting, exciting, and fun.

I think the highlights of the trip were the visit to Norfolk Island and The Bay of Islands in New Zealand. And walking around the Sky Tower in Auckland - outside on a one meter platform with no handrails 192 meters above the ground... but that's another story!

Radiowise, a mixed blessing. Conditions 20 meters and above were not good.

Most of the contacts were made on 30 and 40 meters. The number of contacts were: FK/AI5P - 1716 (98% on CW), YJ0PX - 2003 (95% on CW), AI5P/VK9N - 1838 (87% on CW), and ZL/AI5P - 375 (100% on CW). I'm not sure if conditions, my little signal, or lack of interest caused a (to me) decline in ADXA callers. I did, however, manage to work at least one ADXA member from each of the locations. Of the total 5932 contacts, 3439 (58%) were on 30 meters - definitely the workhorse band on this trip. I will try to give some detailed travel adventures in following issues of the Newsletter.

Despite the low sunspot average throughout most of 2009 there have been a number of successful DXpeditions. The "state of the art" for DXpeditons seems to be improving with better rigs and antennas these days.

The TX3A effort is a case in point. Two guys, George, AA7JV, and Tomi, HA7RY, are cranking out Q's on the low bands with a minimal amount of hardware. They have a pair of K3s, two SGC-500 amps and one 1.5kW generator. What they are doing is akin to fishing for a 25lb brown trout with 4lb test line! They are using some innovative lowband Rx antennas to help overcome the high ambient noise level. A number of ADXA members have hooked up with them on 160, 80, etc.

We have a great program lined up for the Annual Meeting. Joel, W5ZN, will be on had to do a presentation on his multi-bay Low Band antenna array. Joel used this new secret weapon to win 1st place, Delta Division, Single Op, High Power, 80M single band, in the 2009 ARRL International DX CW Contest. Joel had 571 Qs with 84 Multipliers. Also, David, K5UZ, will be on hand to deliver a K5D presentation provided by Bob, K4UEE. David will also share his research and analysis of forces on rotating towers with big antennas lashed to them.

We need some new blood in the group...please recruit a friend and bring them to the meeting.

Map to ADXA Meeting


1 Cooperative Way
